Risk Assessment for Child/Youth Church-Sponsored Activities

Two-Dimension Risk Assessment Framework*

Risk of a proposed child-related activity is to be rated based on a consideration of two dimensions of risk: *likelihood of occurrence* and *possible consequence*.

The rating scales for measuring these dimensions are:

Likelihood of occurrence:

A - Almost certain

B – Likely

C - Possible

D – Unlikely

E – Rarely

Possible consequence (impact) in the event of an occurrence:

- 1 Extreme: death; major financial loss; potential for legal action
- 2 Major: extensive injury; public and media embarrassment
- 3 Moderate: medical treatment; unwanted financial loss
- 4 Minor: First aid; little public interest; negligible financial loss
- 5 Trivial: no injury, financial loss or media interest

Overall Rating of Risk:

These two dimensions of risk can be combined to determine an overall rating of risk (High; Significant; Medium; or Low) using the following grid:

	Extreme	Major	Moderate	Minor	Trivial
Almost Certain	High	High	High	Significant	Medium
Likely	High	High	Significant	Medium	Medium
Possible	High	High	Significant	Medium	Low
Unlikely	High	Significant	Medium	Low	Low
Rarely	Significant	Significant	Medium	Low	Low

The overall rating of risk, as determined above, should be included on the Activity Risk Report submitted to the Church Board for activity approval.
